Perseus Mining Côte d'Ivoire SA is part of the Australian based Perseus Mining Limited Group, mining around 6 Mtpa of ore and waste from multiple pits at its Sissingué Gold Mine. The Sissingué processing facility has been designed as a 1 Mtpa processing facility, capable of producing at a rate of 75,000oz gold per annum.

The role of **Senior Maintenance Planner** will be responsible for the upkeep of the CMMS, ensuring that all preventive and breakdown maintenance are carried out in a timely and cost-effective manner and will report to the Maintenance Superintendent, working 6-weeks on 3 weeks off FIFO roster.

Key responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Manage the maintenance planning function to ensure that the work scheduling process is being performed and meeting targeted KPIs
- Prepare a rolling six monthly forecast of major component change outs according to the equipment maintenance strategies
- Continually review the work order history to optimize component change out intervals and eliminate recurring defects
- Ensure that Pronto information is kept accurate and up to date
- Assist in preparing the annual budget (operating and capital) for the department
- Ensure all components and parts are on site four weeks prior to the scheduled component change out date
- Ensure that all work assigned is completed in an efficient and timely manner
- Keep classified plant records up to date
- Monitor, check and liaise with workshop personnel (both in-house & contractor workshops) to ensure that maintenance works are carried out as planned and scheduled
- Enforce and maintain Company Code of Conduct and compliance with Company Standards, procedures, rules and guidelines
- Actively coach and mentor planners to improve overall skill base and annual leave relief capabilities, inclusive of resource succession planning

Requirements:

- Trade qualifications or Diploma in a maintenance or other related field.
- Five (5) years process plant maintenance planning experience
- Ability to read vehicle and equipment manuals
- Ability to read vendor manuals to decipher parts and equipment successfully
